RESIDENTIAL HOME FOR THE ELDERLY

Tynwald Residential Home is a secure and comfortable home set in a pleasant hillside position in Hythe. It was established as a charity in 1961 to provide a home for elderly persons resident or related to a person living in the Hythe area.

Tynwald is managed by 5 trustees who have all lived in Hythe for many years and voluntarily bring a wealth of experience and expertise to the home.

Whilst respecting independence, residents are offered 24 hour care and support by a team of qualified, caring staff.



A selection of 24 bedrooms, each attractively decorated and many with sea views are available on 2 floors. Each room is tastefully furnished, although residents may bring their own furniture and are encouraged to bring small personal items to create their own homely atmosphere. Each bedroom has a call alarm system.

There is a large lounge with a colour television receiving Sky with a DVD player, and a spacious conservatory.

Residents have use of the beautiful, well kept gardens in which they can wander at leisure or sit in the shade of the veranda.

There is a lift to the first floor and Parker baths fitted in two of the bathrooms. The home is fitted with a fire alarm system approved by the Kent Fire Brigade.

Staff also provide a cleaning and laundry service.

Meals are served in the attractive panelled dining room



and the food is home cooked to the highest standard using local fresh produce whenever possible. A choice of menu is provided and special diets catered for. Although food is provided throughout the day, there is a small kitchen available to residents or guests who wish to provide extra drinks or snacks.

Hobbies and pastimes are encouraged, as is an involvement in the local community. Tynwald regularly provides activities, such as keep-fit, raffles, bingo, craft afternoons, religious services and outings.

Residents are also able to participate in gardening, flower arranging or painting in the sunny conservatory.
